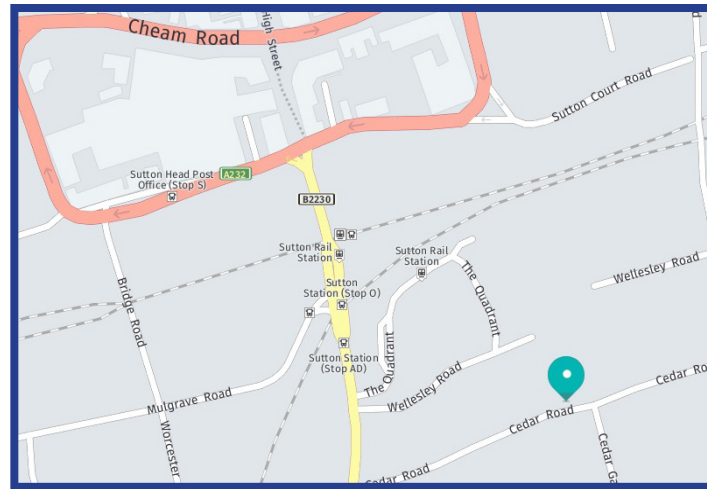

What is the Inspire Partnership?

Inspire is the drug and alcohol service for Sutton, delivered by Cranstoun in partnership with South West London and St George's Mental Health NHS Trust and Sutton GP services.

Who is the service for?

Our services are available to anyone aged 18 and over, living in Sutton. We also run a service for under 18s called Switch Sutton.

What support does Inspire provide?

Inspire offers a wide range of easily accessible and recovery-focused services tailored to your personal needs. These include:

- Information and advice
- Assessments
- Harm reduction including needle exchange
- One to one support
- Counselling
- Group work
- Prescribing
- Outreach
- Health and wellbeing
- GP shared care
- Community detoxification
- Family and carer support
- Access to detox and rehab-detox packages
- Breaking Free Online – a companion app to use on your smartphone
- Physical health and wellbeing assessments and support
- Transition support from our young person's service

Our Recovery Hub also offers:

- Mutual aid and peer-led support
- Peer mentoring
- Volunteer schemes
- Education, training and employment
